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IDTA DANCE MASTER UK

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Applications to organize heats for the Miss Dance/Dance Master UK Competition sponsored by the International Dance Teachers' Association are granted under the following conditions.

Miss Dance/Dance Master UK is a National competition in Theatre Dance. The Grand Final is provisionally arranged for 9 June 2019.

The total value of prizes will be in excess of £4,000. The following rules for the Miss Dance of Great Britain event are reviewed annually.

RULES

1. Competitors must be 16 years of age by 31st May 2019.
2. Competitors will be required to give a completed theatrical dance performance which may include, Modern Jazz, Tap, Gymnastic Dance, Dialogue, Song, Instrumentation, or Comedy, (Classical ballet, Character, Greek, National are not permitted). **Due to health and safety only small properties that can be carried by one person will be permitted.**
3. Non vocal or vocal music may be used but 'Vocal' may not be used to enhance the natural voice. Standing miming to the song is not allowed and the dance must be relevant to the vocal. For finals day the music must be forwarded immediately after winning a heat by email, to the IDTA Music Coordinator Mrs J Kirkland, email jkirkland@btinternet.com for transfer on to iPod to be played through the Opera House theatre's sound system. In the event of a technical failure, a back up track using either of the following devices USB/ipad/ipod has to be available on the day of the final.
4. For the 2019 Heats and Grand Final microphones or radio mics are permitted. These will only be provided by the IDTA on the day of the Finals.
5. Maximum time limit of 3 minutes. No play off allowed.
6. The same dance and musical arrangement must be used throughout the heats and finals. Any alteration will result in disqualification.
7. The adjudicator's decision is final and no correspondence may be entered into.
8. The winning heat competitors must gain a minimum of 85% of marks to dance at the Finals. Plaques are awarded to the heat winner and runner up. Heat winners may not enter any other qualifying heat.

9. Dance Master must be staged as a separate event.
10. The winner of Miss Dance and Dance Master UK are not eligible to enter the event in future years.
11. The first day of entry for the 2019 title will be 11 June 2018 and the last day for heat entries will be 31 May 2019. Any further heat winners after this date will be passed into the year 2020 event.
12. Heat adjudicators must hold an IDTA Fellowship qualification, or an equivalent qualification with another recognised Association i.e. ADA, BATD, BBO, ISTD, NATD, NCDTA, RAD, SDTA, UKA.
13. An independent panel selected by the Miss Dance Committee will adjudicate at the Finals of Miss Dance.
14. Competitors not completing their performance will be disqualified and not be permitted to re-dance. Competitors may re-dance only in the event of music failure.
15. Heat Organisers may not make additional conditions to the rules and the adjudicator must be made aware of all rulings.
16. Heats must not be closed until there are a minimum of 30 competitors. – Miss Dance heats must not have more than 45 competitors.
17. Should a heat winner not be able to participate at the Finals, they must inform Mrs Sharon Berry, the Heat Winners Co-ordinator immediately and providing the runner up of the heat has gained the required 85% mark, they may be invited to dance at the Finals. 18. The IDTA engages an official photographer to take images of the competitors during the finals and that the images may be used by the IDTA in reports of the event and IDTA promotional materials, which is published by the IDTA in a variety of formats.
